



9 Sports To Try





Dressage: A horse and rider perform a series of movements set out in a test with precision and fluidity.





Endurance: An equestrian sport based on controlled long-distance rides.





Eventing: An equestrian sport that includes three phases: Dressage, Cross-Country, and Show Jumping.





Mounted Games: A set of games that are played on ponies up to a height of about 148cm (14.2 h).





Polo: Is like hockey on horseback! Alongside your team you have to hit the ball into the goal with your polo stick.



9 Sports To Try





Polocrosse: A combination of polo and lacrosse. It is a team sport played on horseback, using net racquets to pick up, carry, throw, catch and bounce a soft sponge ball.





Pony Racing: The gateway for introducing members to the world of horse racing.





Show Jumping: A horse and rider are required to jump a series of obstacles that have been designed for a particular show, usually within a time limit.





Tetrathlon: A team and individual competition comprised of Shooting, Swimming, Running and Riding.
