The test may be commanded.



4th Error Elimination

Discreet use of the rider's voice is permitted in local Branch/Centre competitions and Foundation PC70 Area Competitions and Championships as a supportive aid. It must be used in a way that is unobtrusive and does not disturb the adjacent arena(s). Foul language and obscenities are not permitted and will result in elimination.

A competitor whose hat comes off or chinstrap comes undone whilst riding in the competition must, on penalty of elimination replace it or do it up before continuing. He may dismount without penalty to recover the hat or have it passed up from the ground, or he may stop without penalty to do up the chinstrap.

The A, F, B, M, C, H, E, K Letter Markers should be placed about 50 cms outside the Arena.

The G, X and D Letters are not marked on the Arena.
