

Reasonable Adjustment Process

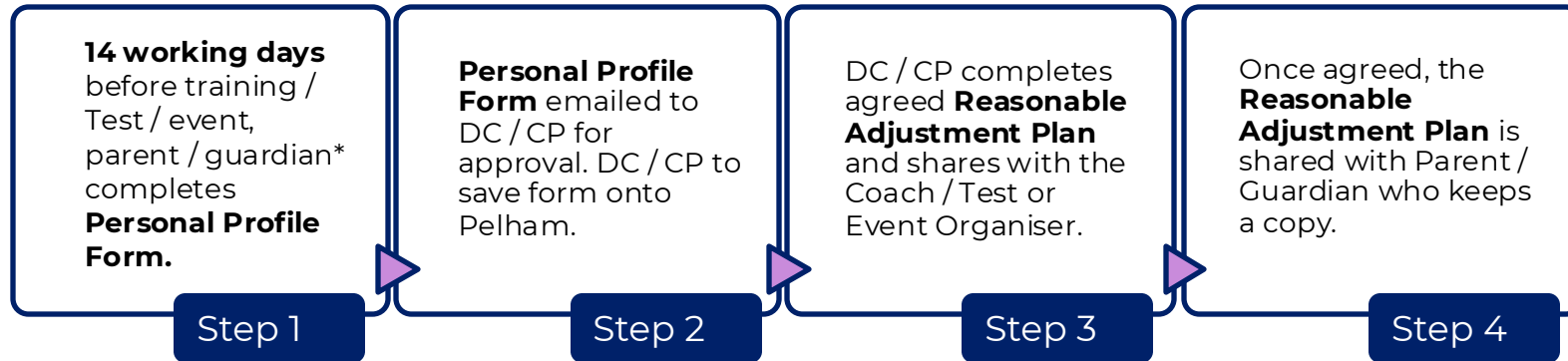


A Reasonable Adjustment is a change to an activity that helps reduce the impact of a physical or mental health condition, (including temporary conditions) ensuring the individual is not disadvantaged. In assessments or competitions, adjustments can be made to the process or method, but not the criteria, competence must still be demonstrated.
